Applying for Admission to CSU-PUEBLO

Colorado State University-Pueblo welcomes applications from individuals interested in a university education. Students with non-traditional backgrounds are encouraged to apply.

The admission process promotes diversity within the student body and assures equal access to qualified applicants. The final admission decision is based upon the applicant's potential for attaining a degree at the University.

GENERAL FRESHMAN ADMISSION:

To be considered for admission, applicants need to submit the following:

- 1) a completed CSU-Pueblo application;
- 2) a \$25 application fee (non-refundable);
- 3) official high school transcripts, GED, or home school evaluation form or portfolio; and
- 4) ACT or SAT test results.

GENERAL TRANSFER ADMISSION

If you have attended or are now attending another institution of higher education and are seeking admission to CSU-Pueblo for the first time, you are considered a transfer student and must submit the following:

- 1) a completed CSU-Pueblo application;
- 2) a \$25 application fee (non-refundable);
- 3) an official transcript from each institution attended sent directly to CSU-Pueblo from the institution; and
- 4) ACT or SAT scores and a final high school transcript or GED scores if you have less than 13 semester hours of transferable college credit or if you have less than 30 hours of transferable credit and you graduated from high school in 2008 or later.

Transfer students must be in good standing at the institution last attended and have at least a 2.3 grade-point-average.
